- 1. Will both Section 1 and Section 2 of SF330 be required?
 - a. Section 1 only. Here is a link to form SF330.
- 2. Will the SF330 be required of all [sub]consultants?
 - a. Please include primary team members on the form that are also included in the main body of your RFQ response in illustrating your team's qualifications for fulfilling the requirements of the predesign. It is not necessary nor required to have a complete consultant team listed in your response to the RFQ.
- 3. Does the SF330 form count toward the page limit in the response PDF?
 - a. No
- 4. The RFQ asks for up to six projects in the relevant project experience section. May we include more on the SF330 form?
 - a. Yes, please fill out the SF330 as you see fit within the content of the form.
- 5. Are tabs included in the 40-page limit?
 - a. No, tabs can be exempt from the page limit. Please number the pages in the PDF to indicate which pages are included, per the RFQ requirements, in the 40 page count.
- 6. Will team members who participate in the predesign be precluded from participating in subsequent design or construction phases of the project?
 - a. No
- 7. What is the anticipated delivery process for the design and construction of the project?
 - a. This will be determined during the predesign phase.
- 8. Does Western have participation goals for participation by certified OMWBE firms?
 - a. No, but we take participation and team diversity seriously in considering which firms to select for all our qualifications-based selection processes.
- 9. Is it anticipated that the stakeholder engagement process will include outside industry partners?
 - a. This is plausible, particularly for the Poulsbo project, but the cybersecurity program will be a new building type for Western, so external stakeholders are yet to be determined.
